Concrete Batch Plant & Loader Operator

Summary:

Kuhlman Corporation, based in Maumee, OH, is one of the largest producers of ready-mixed concrete in Northwest Ohio and Southeast Michigan. We are seeking an experienced individual to run a concrete batch plant who can also operate and maintain a front-end loader.

Location: Northwest Ohio and Southeast Michigan

Compensation: Per union contract, currently \$21.48/hour. Comprehensive employee benefits, including health care and pension. Full-time position.

Hours of Work: Normally Monday through Friday or Saturday, with staggered start times when necessary to cover production schedules. Work on weekends, evening and nights anticipated during the construction season.

Responsibilities:

- Controls production and load out of material produced in concrete batch plant.
- Batches concrete loads according to product specifications.
- Performs preventative maintenance, repairs and cleaning of plant equipment.
- Coordinates, receives and manages inbound deliveries of raw materials.
- Maintains time and material records. Estimates raw material inventories on hand.
- Conducts quality-control testing on concrete mixes.
- Professionally utilizes a front-end loader to charge aggregate bins, load trucks, and maintain stockpiles.
- Performs preventative maintenance and repairs on loaders and related equipment.
- Works safely at all times. Maintains a clean and safe work environment.
- Performs all duties in a professional and courteous manner, and complies with all Company policies and procedures.
- Other duties as assigned.

Required Skills:

- High school diploma or general-education degree (GED).
- Experience in operating a concrete batch plant strongly preferred. Ready-mixed concrete experience highly desirable, including 1) past or current experience working for a ready-mixed concrete producer, 2) knowledge of concrete mixes, and 3) professional batching/dispatching experience.
- Must maintain an ACI Concrete Field Testing Technician-Grade 1 certification. If not currently certified, course completion will be required within 12 months of hire.
- Extensive mechanical, electrical and hydraulic knowledge, skills and experience. Be able to pass relevant competency tests. Willing to pursue job-related continuing education.

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Required Skills (Continued):

- Welding and burning skills desirable.
- Efficient and safe operation of a front-end loader, as demonstrated by training and experience.
- Able to safely climb and descend ladders. Must be able to lift and carry 100 pounds.
- Strong interpersonal, customer-service, math, and computer skills.
- Ability to communicate effectively in person and on the phone.
- Team player, with the ability to build positive relationships.
- Works safely. Displays initiative. Is always on time. Has an excellent attendance history.
- Does not abuse alcohol or use drugs. Kuhlman Corporation is a drug-free workplace.
- Ability to multi-task in a fast-paced environment.

Clothing Requirements:

- Long pants of durable construction provided by the employee. Pants must be tear-free and clean. Pants must be full-length and not loose fitting.
- Fluorescent shirt or other high-visibility work shirt/jacket provided by the Company. Shirts must be tear-free and clean.
- 8" work boots with non-slip tread and steel toes provided through the Company's work-boot program. The Company requires that employees only wear specific makes/models of work boots from an approved vendor and provides the employee with a subsidy of up to \$100/year for this purpose. Work boots must be free of holes or tears.
- Waterproof gloves, safety glasses, hardhat, high-visibility clothing, and other personal protective equipment to be worn as directed.
