Hours of Work

Normally Monday through Friday or Saturday, with staggered start times when necessary to cover production schedules. Work on weekends, evening and nights anticipated during the construction season.

Responsibilities

- Perform preventative maintenance on ready-mixed concrete trucks and other equipment.
- Maintain equipment logs.
- Retrieve and repair disabled vehicles.
- Works safely at all times. Maintain a clean and safe work environment.
- Perform all duties in a professional and courteous manner, and comply with all Company policies and procedures.
- Other duties as assigned.

Required Skills

- Efficient and safe maintenance of vehicles, as demonstrated by training and experience, in:
 - Diesel engines.
 - Drive trains, including transmissions, clutches, and axles.
 - Truck systems, including lubrication, cooling, fuel, electrical, hydraulic, suspension, steering and exhaust.
 - Brakes. Possess ASE brake certification, or obtain within six months of hire.
 - Welding and burning skills, with certificate preferred.
- Possess and maintain a Commercial Driver's License (CDL), or willingness to obtain within 12 months of hire.
- Possess and maintain mechanics tools.
- Able to safely climb and descend ladders. Must be able to lift and carry 100 pounds.

Required Skills (Continued)

- Strong interpersonal, math, and computer skills.
- Ability to communicate effectively in person and on the phone.
- Team player, with the ability to build positive relationships.
- Works safely. Displays initiative. Is always on time. Has an excellent attendance history.
- Does not abuse alcohol or use drugs. Kuhlman Corporation is a drug-free workplace.
- Ability to multi-task in a fast-paced environment.

Clothing Requirements

- Wear uniforms provided by the Company.
- 8" work boots with non-slip tread and steel toes provided through the Company's work-boot program. The Company requires that employees only wear specific makes/models of work boots from an approved vendor and provides the employee with a subsidy of up to \$100/year for this purpose. Work boots must be free of holes or tears.
- Waterproof gloves, safety glasses, hardhat, high-visibility clothing, and other personal protective equipment to be worn as directed.
